

WVTA Death Benefit Clause

“In the event of a teacher who is in the employ of the Board, the Board shall pay to the designated beneficiary, to the estate of the deceased if there be no designated beneficiary, an amount equal to “ONE FULL MONTH’S current salary.

This payment shall be in the addition to any amount earned by the deceased during the last month he/she served.”

We sincerely hope that this benefit will never be needed. However, in the event of death, the benefit will provide survivors with a full month’s salary **while the estate is being settled.**

In order to avoid confusion, we have provided you with examples of appropriate beneficiaries. Please indicate the name of the beneficiary and his/her relationship to you.

Example:	one beneficiary	- Jane Elizabeth Doe (wife) - William Arthur Smith (no relation) - Peter James (common-law spouse)
	two beneficiaries	- Jane Doe and Ann Doe (sisters) (Note: please use AND, not OR)

As indicated in the above clause, if you do not indicate a beneficiary, this amount will revert to your estate.
